

Livingston County 4-H Scholarship

Background & Purpose:

The scholarship was established in 2007 by Livingston County 4-H in memory of Russell B. Ace. Mr. Ace was the Livingston County 4-H Agent from 1929 to 1959. The intent of this scholarship is to recognize one current 4-H member who has demonstrated leadership skills and served their community through their active participation in the Livingston County 4-H program. The winner will be awarded a one-time scholarship of \$1000 to be used toward a secondary education program, resulting in a certification or degree. The scholarship will be applied to the last semester of the first academic year or after successful completion of a certificate program.



Requirements:

To qualify for the scholarship, applicant must be a high school senior who is actively enrolled in the Livingston County 4-H program in good standing and been enrolled in any 4-H program for 5 years.

To apply for this award, applicants need to complete a “Livingston County Russell B. Ace Memorial Scholarship Application” and submit it to the 4-H office by May 2nd. The completed application will include the application form; the 4-H member’s Summary Book or other documentation of 4-H activities; two letters of recommendation (one must be from a teacher or academic advisor and the second from anyone familiar with your 4-H achievements); and participation in an interview with the selection committee.

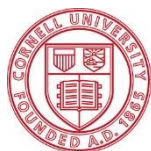
Criteria for Selection:

25% on demonstrated leadership within 4-H, their community and school; 25% on their service to community through 4-H and extracurricular activities; 40% on their 4-H project work; 5% on recommendations received; 5% on their interview.

Selection Procedure:

Selection will be made by a committee appointed by the Youth Development Team Coordinator. The committee will accept applicants based on an accurately completed application form. Initial review of all applications will be anonymous. The scholarship will be awarded at the annual Achievement Day awards ceremony.

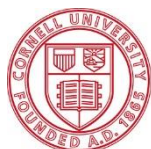
