



Large Animal – Market & Breed Class Video Entries



Beef, Dairy, Swine, Sheep & Goat

Rules:

- Videos should be no longer than 2 minutes (including the introduction)
- The focus of the video should be on the youth and the animal
- Youth should be the only one handling their animal throughout the video
 - Parents or a sibling may **assist** with younger members
- There is to be no props and/or past ribbons/trophies/banners in the video frame
- Parents should refrain from giving instructions during the video
- Videos may not be edited

Submitting Videos:

- All videos **MUST** be submitted through the provided links.
 - Links will be emailed, posted on our website, and added to this document when available
- Submission deadlines can be found in the animal timeline. If your video submission does not meet the deadline it will not be included.

Your Video:

When you first start recording your video provide a 10-20 second introduction. This introduction will be used for video entry identification. After the introduction, you may move right into showing your animal. Please include the following:

- Your full name
- Division (Species), Breed, & Class Name
- Animal Tag Number
- Birthdate of your animal
- Approximate weight (market only)
- Any other information you feel is important to provide the judge
 - Do not list past achievements

If you choose to do your introduction with your animal already with you, move right into the next section. If you are unable to have your animal out when recording your intro, just pause your recording, get your animal, and then continue recording when you and your animal are ready. This way your video entry is one video

- Walk your animal as if you were in the show ring. The person recording the video is the judges' viewpoint. Keep that in mind as you are walking your animal.
- Views of the animal to include in your video:
 - Front
 - Rear
 - Profile
 - Walk your animal to show each view. Once each view has been shown, stop and set your animals feet. The person recording may then walk around the animal to show each view again
 - Hogs only need to be walked just like a normal in-person show

Group Class Entries

- Place all animals entered in the group class side by side
 - Enter 2 photos
 - One front view of the whole group
 - One rear view of the whole group
- Things to keep in mind
 - Animals may only be entered into a maximum of 3 classes (showmanship does not count towards those 3 classes)
 - The fair entry system will restrict this
 - Please make sure tag numbers and any other additional information is accurate

Beef, Swine & Lamb Class Schedule:

- **June 29th:** Publicity photos, biography information, estimated weight for all auction animals due. These will be submitted through [FairEntry.com](https://www.fairentry.com). when completing class entries.
- **June 29th:** Showmanship, breed, market, & group class video entries due
 - *Early submissions preferred and appreciated!*
- **July 3rd – 8th:** Class video entries judged
- **July 13th - 16th (Dates & Times TBA):** Class results and reasons provided to participants via Zoom
- **July 17th – 20th:** Online livestock auction is open for bidding
- **July 22nd – 24th:** Auction buyer information emailed to members
- **July 26th 12pm-3pm:** Animals sold at the auction brought to the Hemlock Fairgrounds for trucking to processors. Trucking provided from fairgrounds to processors. All animals MUST be at the fairgrounds by 3pm.

Dairy & Goat Class Schedule:

- **July 6th:** Showmanship & breed class video entries due
- **July 10th – 15th:** Class video entries judged
- **July 20th – 23rd: (Dates & Times TBA):** Class results and reasons provided to participants via Zoom
