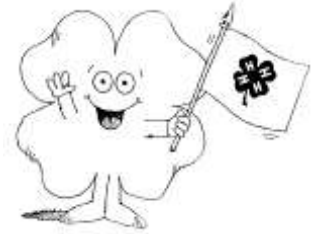


## Cloverbud Creative Fiber Arts Revue Tips

1. The evaluator will ask you a few questions about what you made for the Creative Fiber Arts Revue. You will feel more confident if you practice answering these questions at home. Practice with your 4-H leader, your parent, or an older sibling a few minutes every day during the week before the revue.



2. These are sample questions:

- What is your name? How old are you? What did you bring to show me?
- How did you make this?
- What will you use it for?
- What other things have you done in 4-H?



Additional Questions for 7 year olds:

- How much did it cost to make this?
- What would you like to make next year?

3. Practice “showing off” the article you made for the revue portion of the event. Pretend you are on stage or in front of a crowd. Stand or hold your item so the audience can see it well. As you are walking across the stage, turn it to both your left then to your right so the people on both sides can see it. Stop and hold it still for a moment before you “walk off the stage”.
