COMMONLY ASKED ENROLLMENT QUESTIONS:

<u>Residence</u>: What is a **Farm** vs. **Rural** in the Residence Section? A Farm indicates that your family generates income from farming (at least \$10,000 per year). Most hobby farms would be considered Rural, not Farm.

Youth Section:

<u>Project Areas</u>: These are the areas your child expects to learn about/participate in during the coming 4-H year. You can find a list of project areas here:

<u>Club Name</u>: You can belong to more than one club and/or be both in a club and do things independently in 4-H. Just try to connect the Project Area with the Club you are doing that with. For instance, you might be doing Arts & Crafts with the Lucky Clovers Club and Poultry Independently.

Why do we ask for **Race** and **Ethnicity** information? 4-H receives federal funding and is asked each year to collect and submit demographics reflective of the population we serve.

<u>Photo Release</u>: We used photos primarily in our Livingston Livewire newsletter and other publications, Facebook posts, website and in marketing publications.

<u>COVID Assumption of Risk</u>: If you are planning to attend any in-person activities, we need to have this form signed.

<u>Acknowledgment of Risk</u>: Be sure to include all youth names in the appropriate activity boxes based on what you expect to be doing in the coming year.

<u>Signatures</u>: We need **all youth** to sign the form (even 5-year-olds) printing is fine as well as electronic signatures. The form isn't complete without these signatures.
