

Community Impact

FARMS & GARDENS

Agriculture is the biggest industry in Livingston County with 189,000 acres in production and a total market value of \$153 Million. We are a member of the NWNY Dairy, Livestock, & Field Crops Team which provides educational programming and individual assistance. Additional gardening support provided through print media, our Master Gardener Program, and more.



NUTRITION

Approx. 1 in 10 individuals (1 in 6 children) are considered food insecure in Livingston County. We provide education and resources to help improve eating habits and hydration, increase the intake of local fruits and vegetables, and introduce food preservation techniques. Pressure canner gauge testing is also available by appointment.

YOUTH PROGRAMMING

4-H is the world's largest youth-serving organization - open to ages 5-18. Livingston County's program has 200+ youth members and 60 adult volunteers. The Ag in the Classroom Program works with public/private schools to provide hands-on lessons that foster an awareness for how agriculture impacts our daily lives. More than 500 lessons provided each school year - with Incubation & Embryology being the most popular.



FAMILIES

We provide programming on child development, effective discipline, dealing with divorce - and home safety education/equipment. Over 500 hours of instruction provided annually with a 90% graduation rate. Our Traffic Safety program also offers car seat and bicycle helmet safety checks, low income car seat distribution, bicycle rodeos, and an annual youth safety fair.
