FARMS & GARDENS

We collaborate with the NWNY Dairy, Livestock, & Field Crops Team to provide diverse educational programming and personal guidance. We support farmers and consumers in building a sustainable local food system. Master Gardener volunteers empower residents with knowledge and support. We also foster connections between consumers and local farmers, promoting community engagement in agriculture.

NUTRITION

Some Livingston County communities are considered "nutritionally underserved" due to a lack of access to affordable and healthy food options. We provide education and resources to improve eating habits, stretch "food dollars", increase the intake of fruits and vegetables, and introduce food preservation techniques with the help of our Master Food Preserver volunteers. Pressure canner gauge testing available.

Fundraising Goal: \$1000

Community Impact Target: Eliminate financial barrier for three families by providing them with canning equipment upon completion of food preservation training.



TRAFFIC SAFETY

Our Traffic Safety program offers car seat and bicycle helmet safety checks, low income car seat distribution, bicycle rodeos, and an annual safety fair. We also provide resources about a number of topics - including teen and older driver safety. Spanish resources available. This is a grantfunded program with specific limitations on how money can be spent.

Fundraising Goal: \$600

Community Impact Target: Purchase an air compressor and repair donated bicycles.

YOUTH PROGRAMMING

4-H is the world's largest youth-serving organization, open to ages 5-18. Livingston County's program has 200+ members and 60 adult volunteers. Enrollment is currently underway and runs through 4/30. The Ag in the Classroom Program works with public/private schools to provide hands-on lessons that foster an awareness for how agriculture impacts our daily lives. More than 500 lessons provided each school year - with Incubation & Embryology being the most popular.
