Parent Education Program

Parenting is one of the hardest jobs in the world. We offer classes to help families navigate the toddler and teen years, as well as support for life events like divorce and separation. Donations to the program will be used to purchase teaching materials and provide scholarships to those needing assistance with registration fees.

Ex. The Parents Apart registration fee is \$50/person.

Nutrition Program

We offer lots of useful information on food-related topics from food safety and nutrition to healthy eating on a budget. We also help connect residents with the abundance of healthy, locally grown and produced food in our county. Donations will be used to offset the cost of educational workshops and purchase supplies for cooking demonstrations at Livingston County Farmer's Markets and other locations across the county.

Ex. \$10 provides 50 samples at a Farmer's Market.

Traffic Safety Program

Bike safety, helmet usage, car seat safety (inc. safety check events by certified technicians), and car safety to help older drivers remain behind the wheel are all part of the Traffic Safety Program. Donations will be used to purchase teaching materials, rewards/prizes for youth education, assistive devices for older drivers, etc.

- **Rewards/Prizes** - Ex. Bikes awarded to Coloring Contest Winners average \$120/each.
- **Older Driver Safety** - Ex. Safety devices for seniors cost approx. \$30.
- **Teen Driving Safety** - Ex. Help support the purchase of a driving simulator.

Agriculture Program

Demonstration gardens to share knowledge about growing landscape and edible plants, Master Gardener and Master Naturalist volunteer trainings, classes on pasture management and equine practices are all part of our growing agriculture program. Donations will be used to purchase teaching materials or defray costs associated with printing our publications.

- **Master Gardeners** - Ex. \$50 helps one volunteer attend required trainings.
- **Demo. Garden** - Ex. \$50 purchases a native shrub or three native perennials.
- **Adult Education** - \$50 helps purchase teaching materials or a scholarship for a future program.
- **Sponsor Publications** - Our publications include the *Gardening Gazette* or *AgNews*.

Agriculture in the Classroom Program

We offer enrichment to teachers in all 10 Livingston County school districts through our Ag Literacy celebration, embryology project, farm tours, and more. By putting agriculture directly into the hands of students, we are able to share the benefits of agriculture while increasing student/teacher understanding of where food comes from. **Contact our office for business sponsorship opportunities.**

- **Incubation & Embryology Project** - Ex. One dozen fertilized eggs can be purchased for \$20; All of the materials needed for one classroom to participate can be purchased for \$225.
- **Farm Tours** - Ex. \$500 buys 1500 cheesesticks for students to snack on during event. Can be adjusted to provide a larger meal based on available funds.
- **Ag Literacy Celebration** - Ex. Purchase one copy of the featured book to be donated to the school library or individual classroom for \$15.
- **General Lesson Use** - Ex. \$500 buys supplies/teaching materials for 1000 students. Cost varies based on lesson.
- **Special Lesson Requests*** - Ex. \$40-50 buys supplies/teaching materials for one classroom lesson. Cost varies.
- **Earth Day Tree Lesson**** - Ex. \$25 buys teaching materials and supplies (to help trees grow) for one classroom.

* Teachers request specific lessons based on what students are learning in school and questions that may arise.

** Students are given a pine tree to plant at home.

Livingston County 4-H Program

4-H is the nation's largest positive youth development movement providing kids with community, mentors, and year-round hands-on educational activities to develop the skills they need to create positive change in their lives. The 4-H Program has several program areas available for support.

- **Home Arts** - Ex. \$75 provides program materials for one Activity Night. Previous Activity Nights involve working with robots, clay, sewing, and more.
- **Teen Leadership** - Ex. Help one 4-H member attend a leadership program like Cornell Career Explorations for \$50.
- **Outdoor Education** - Ex. \$50 provides one guided hike at a park. \$70 helps one 4-H member attend our Outdoor Education Weekend.
- **General 4-H Use** - Ex. A \$15 donation would cover the enrollment fee for one youth. A \$40 donation would allow a family of 3+ siblings to enroll in the 4-H Program.
- **Horse Program** - Ex. \$50 would cover all of the costs for a member to exhibit in a 4-H Horse Show – Judges Fee, Rosettes/Awards, Show Supplies.

Your contribution will help cover expenses associated with program resources, educational events, the Hemlock Fair exhibiting/showing experience (prizes, awards, cages, gates, supplies, etc.) and the market animal auction program.
