

Directions for Enrolling & Reenrolling YOUTH in 4-H

- NEW this year, all youth enrollments should be **submitted online** using the link below.
- Up to 5 youth can be enrolled on one form. More than 5 youth? Just use the form multiple times.
- **Fill out each section completely & accurately.**
 - As you move through the sections, please make sure the information you enter is correct AND complete before moving to the next section. *You will NOT be able to go back in most sections and we are not able to override the system.*
- A parent signature is required at the end.
 - If you are completing the form on a device with a touchscreen, simply use your finger to sign.
 - If you are completing the form on a computer, click and drag the mouse to sign.

- Nov. 1 and after
 - \$15 per youth
 - \$40 for a family of 3 or more youth

- **Youth Club Information Section:**

- **Project Areas:** These are the areas your child expects to learn about/participate in during the coming 4-H year. You can find a list of project areas here:

- **Club Name:** You can belong to more than one club and/or be both in a club and do things independently in 4-H. For instance, you might be doing Arts & Crafts with the Lucky Clovers Club and Poultry independently.

- **Why do we ask for Race and Ethnicity information?** 4-H receives federal funding and is asked each year to collect and submit demographics reflective of the population we serve.

- **Photo Release:** We used photos primarily in our Livingston Livewire newsletter and other publications, Facebook posts, website and in marketing publications.

- **Acknowledgment of Risk:** Be sure to check the appropriate activity boxes based on what you expect to be doing in the coming year.

- **Enrollment Fee:** Your enrollment will be complete once the enrollment fee has been received.
