

Hemlock Fair Building Exhibits 101

Setting Up Your Display

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- ▶ Now that all your exhibits have been evaluated, you can set up your display.
- ▶ Club Displays will be labeled. Independent displays may be asked to take a small section of counter space to ensure clubs have enough room for their display.
- ▶ You will have both counter space and a vertical space behind the counter space to use for your display area.
- ▶ If you are part of a club, you will want to work with your club members so that all of your exhibits are displayed well together.
- ▶ Your display should reflect your personality, have color, balance and be appealing to look at.



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- ▶ Consider adding to your Backdrops/Background
 - ▶ Feel free to cover the background and counter space with table clothes, fabric, curtains, or other covering - just remember, you will need to be able to remove it.



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- ▶ Fill up your space!
- ▶ Flat displays are boring and not appealing to look at
- ▶ Add dimension and depth to your display area
 - ▶ Shelves can be used to add height
 - ▶ You can also use boxes or bins with fabric covering them
 - ▶ The vertical space behind your counter space can be used to hang items too



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- ▶ Other Notes:
 - ▶ Ribbons and Entry Tags should be attached to exhibits
 - ▶ Exhibits in the 4-H Building will be on display for the week of the Fair
 - ▶ Thousands of visitors will see all your hard work
 - ▶ Take care to display valuables out of reach of the public
 - ▶ Inverted aquarium tanks over exhibits (or something similar), offer the public the opportunity to view your exhibit without touching them
 - ▶ Your items can be picked up between 8-9pm Saturday evening or Sunday from 10am-12pm.
