



SHOWING LARGE ANIMALS AT HEMLOCK FAIR



REQUIREMENTS TO SHOW

- Own your animal by June 1st
- Complete the Pre-Fair Educational Requirement by July 1st
- Complete class entries through Fair Entry
- Follow all animal health requirements
 - Bring your vet paperwork to the fair!
- Animal(s) must remain at the fairgrounds until Saturday at 8pm
- If you are consigning an animal to the 4-H Livestock Auction, be sure to follow all sale rules & requirements!
- Refer to the Fair 4-H Exhibitors Book for species specific rules and requirements.

FAIR ENTRIES

- All animals must be entered in a market or breed class through Fairentry.com
- All youth exhibiting an animal must enter and participate in a showmanship class
- Cloverbuds will only participate in Cloverbus Showmanship

SHOWMANSHIP

- Youth will be judged on their handling & knowledge of their animal.
- 4-H age youth showing for the first time, may enter the novice showmanship class.
- Cloverbuds will only participate in the Cloverbud Showmanship Class.

MARKET & BREED CLASSES

- All large animals must be exhibited in a market or breed class.
- Breed classes are for registered purebred animals.
- Animals that are crossbred or don't have a registration paper may show in the crossbred class

FAIR INFORMATION

- Arrive at the Hemlock Fair Monday, 2pm-8pm or Tuesday 8:30am-12pm
- Have your animal health checked BEFORE coming off of the trailer
- Find your assigned stall
- Refer to the fairbook for show schedules
